Prior to Matches

We appreciate that people's lives are extremely busy in this day and age, however, to be a successful team we need players that are committed and play as often as they can.

The most successful teams are those with a settled side, where everyone knows their role and takes responsibility for their performance, **if you choose not to play you are letting your Captain/Coach and your team mates down.** Organising teams is a time consuming and thankless task at times, and we all need to do our part to assist captains and coaches with this.

Players will:

- **Solution** Be committed to the team and make themselves available to play whenever possible.
- ✓ Update their availability at least 4 days before match.
- **I**f selected- confirm selection as soon as possible.
- Notify the captain/coach if your availability changes <u>immediately</u> and ensure they have received and acknowledge the message.

During Matches

Pre-match- Players will:

- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the game.
- Assist your captain/coach with any preparation that needs to be done on or off the pitch.
- **Solution** Be ready to start 5 minutes before the start of the match.
- **Wear Club match shirts and caps.**

During Matches- Players will:

- Always adhere to the MCC Spirit of cricket and MSC Codes of conduct.
- Not engaging in 'sledging' at any point.
- Not question or criticize umpires' decisions by word or action.
- Assist with scoring and umpiring if required- if you do not know how to, ask, we will help you.
- ✓ Update the scoreboard <u>every over</u>.
- **Help look for the ball if required.**
- Help move sight screens if required.
- Watch the game and support your teammates.
- Take responsibility for your performance. If you are under performing work on your game, train harder, seek help and advice from coaches and teammates.

Post-Match- Players will:

- Assist the captain/coach with any clearing away on/off the field.
- Respect our venue and surroundings at the end of the game whole team to make sure all rubbish is in the bin and changing room and pavilion is clean and tidy.
- Stay and socialise with the team whenever possible.
